Emergency Contact Procedures

The most important help you can provide to a victim who is seriously injured is to call for professional medial help. Make the call quickly, preferably from a cell phone near the injured person. If this is not possible, send someone else to make the call from a nearby telephone. Be sure that you or another caller follows these steps.

- 1) Dial 9-1-1.
- 2) Give the dispatcher the necessary information. Answer any questions he or she may ask. Most dispatchers will ask:
 - The exact location or address of the emergency? Our address is: 300 N. Lakeshore Boulevard. Cross Streets are: Lakeshore Boulevard, North Wales Drive, and Springer Drive.
 - The telephone number from which the call is being made?
 - The caller's name?
 - What happened? Provide as much detail as possible.
 - How many people are involved?
 - The condition of the injured person?
 - What help is being given?
- **3)** Do not hang up until the dispatcher hangs up. The dispatcher will tell you how to best care for the victim.
- 4) Continue care for the victim until professional help arrives.
- 5) Appoint someone to go to the nearest street and look for the first responders.
